

Influenza A (H1N1) Vaccine

Dear IMC Patient,

The new vaccine for H1N1 influenza is expected to be available in the coming weeks. All stocks are controlled by the Ministry of Health and distributed to clinics according to our needs. Pandemic Preparedness Clinics (IMC is one of these) will be one of the first in line to receive the stocks.

If you would like to receive the vaccine, we need you to register your interest with us as soon as possible.

Please read the FAQ on our website imc-healthcare.com > **health alerts > Influenza A (H1N1) > Medication Guide to H1N1 Vaccination** before registering your interest, as not everyone will require, nor be suitable, for this vaccine. Currently, **the vaccine is only approved for use in adults above 18 years old**. You may put down your children's names but we will not give them these vaccines until, and unless, the vaccine becomes approved for children. We will keep their names on our register until the appropriate time.

The Ministry of Health has not finalised the number of vaccines that will be allocated to our clinic. As such, we cannot reserve the vaccine for individual patients at the present moment. We will do our best to meet all our patients' requests for the vaccine. However, should there be an overwhelming demand, the Ministry of Health may issue guidelines on who will get priority for the vaccines, which we may have to comply with.
